Crystal Police Explorers are youth between the ages of 15 and 20 who are interested in learning more about a career in law enforcement. The Explorer post is chartered through the Boy Scouts of America, Viking Council, Learning for Life Division. Police Explorers serve in a volunteer capacity and are not compensated for their time.

OPERATION

The Explorers Post is operated under the administration of a Police Sergeant who, with the approval of the Chief of Police, assigns members of the police department to function as Advisors for the Post. The Police Sergeant will serve as the chair of the Post Committee.

The Advisors are responsible for all planned activities, events and training. Any Explorer working an event in uniform will be under the direction and supervision of a Police Officer.

The Crystal Police Explorers are governed by this manual and By-Laws established by post members and approved by the Chief of Police. The Crystal Police Department may work jointly with other departments for leadership, operation, and participation in the Explorer post.

EXPLORER RANK STRUCTURE

The following positions will be assigned by the post administrative Sergeant and Advisors:

- Post President – designated rank of Captain
- Post Quartermaster – designated rank of Sergeant
- Post Recording Secretary – designated rank of Sergeant
